To provide a safe and clean pool facility for the enjoyment of the patrons of the Bloomfield Municipal Pool. The incumbent is responsible for the maintenance and water chemistry of the Bloomfield Municipal Pool. Works closely with the Assistant Director of Bloomfield Leisure Services.

Minimum Qualifications

High School Diploma or equivalent, at least 3 years servicing / working on pools. Certified Pool Operator (CPO) or Aquatic Facility Operator (AFO) certification or the ability to get the certification by the day of appointment. Must have and maintain a valid driver's license.

Selection Process

All appointments shall be made according to merit and fitness for performing the functions of the position, including factors such as education, experience, aptitude, knowledge, character, ethics, or other qualifications that would determine the best candidate for the position. Examinations may include written, oral, physical, or performance tests or any combination of the various types of examinations. Offers of employment are contingent upon satisfactory results on a background check, verification of information on the employment application, pre-employment physical, drug testing, DCF background, state and federal criminal history and background investigation, including fingerprints.

Position Purpose:

To provide a safe and clean pool facility for the enjoyment of the patrons of the Bloomfield Municipal Pool. The Pool Maintainer is responsible for the maintenance and water chemistry of the Bloomfield Municipal Pool.

Job Environment:

While performing the duties of the job the employee is frequently required to climb, reach, kneel, crawl, and have full use of his/her hands. The employee must routinely lift and or move up to 50 lbs. The employee may also be asked to use tools such as wrenches, screwdrivers, hammers, and power tools.

Essential Job Functions:

(The essential functions or duties listed below are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.)

- Ensures safe swimming conditions by continuously monitoring water conditions through
 visible inspection and chemical testing of the water every two hours. (Free Chlorine, Total
 Chlorine and PH). Ability to make adjustments to chemicals to maintain proper sanitation of
 the pool.
- Maintains water quality, records, daily checklists of tasks performed and maintenance accomplished.
- Knowledge of pumps, filters, and pool operations.
- Responsible for pumping / backwashing of the pool filtration systems on the weekends.
- Responsible for vacuuming and skimming of pools.
- May need to clean and maintain the facility including the bathrooms during their evening and weekend shifts.
- Picks up trash and empties all pool trash bins into the dumpster as needed during and at the end of their evening and weekend shifts.

- Informs Pool Director and Assistant Director of Leisure services of any equipment that needs to be serviced or replaced in a timely fashion.
- Maintains positive public relations at the Bloomfield Municipal Pool,
- Assists in the pre-season preparations of getting the Municipal Pool online and ready to open and post season closing of the facility.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Assistant Director of Leisure Services, Pool Director and Head Guards depending on who is in charge at the facility.

Minimum Required Qualifications:

High School Diploma or equivalent, at least 3 years servicing / working on pools. Certified Pool Operator (CPO) or Aquatic Facility Operator (AFO) certification or the ability to get the certification by the day of appointment. .

Special Requirements: Must have and maintain a valid driver's license; CPO or AFO certification

Knowledge, Ability and Skills:

Knowledge:

Knowledge of pumps, filters, and pool operations. Knowledge of water quality. Knowledge of proper sanitation methods and techniques and use of swimming pool chemicals.

Ability:

Ability to anticipate unsafe situations and use preventive measures to eliminate such situations. Ability to make adjustments to chemicals to maintain proper sanitation of the pool. Ability to quickly learn the necessary procedures and methods used to maintain the swimming pool in good working order. Ability to use proper methods of maintenance and/or mechanical repair of the filters. Ability to work independently and under minimal supervision. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.

Skill:

Proficiency in safely handling hazardous materials is needed to adequately perform this job. Must have good record keeping skills to maintain logs of the pool treatment procedures. Math skills are needed to accurately measure chemicals.
