



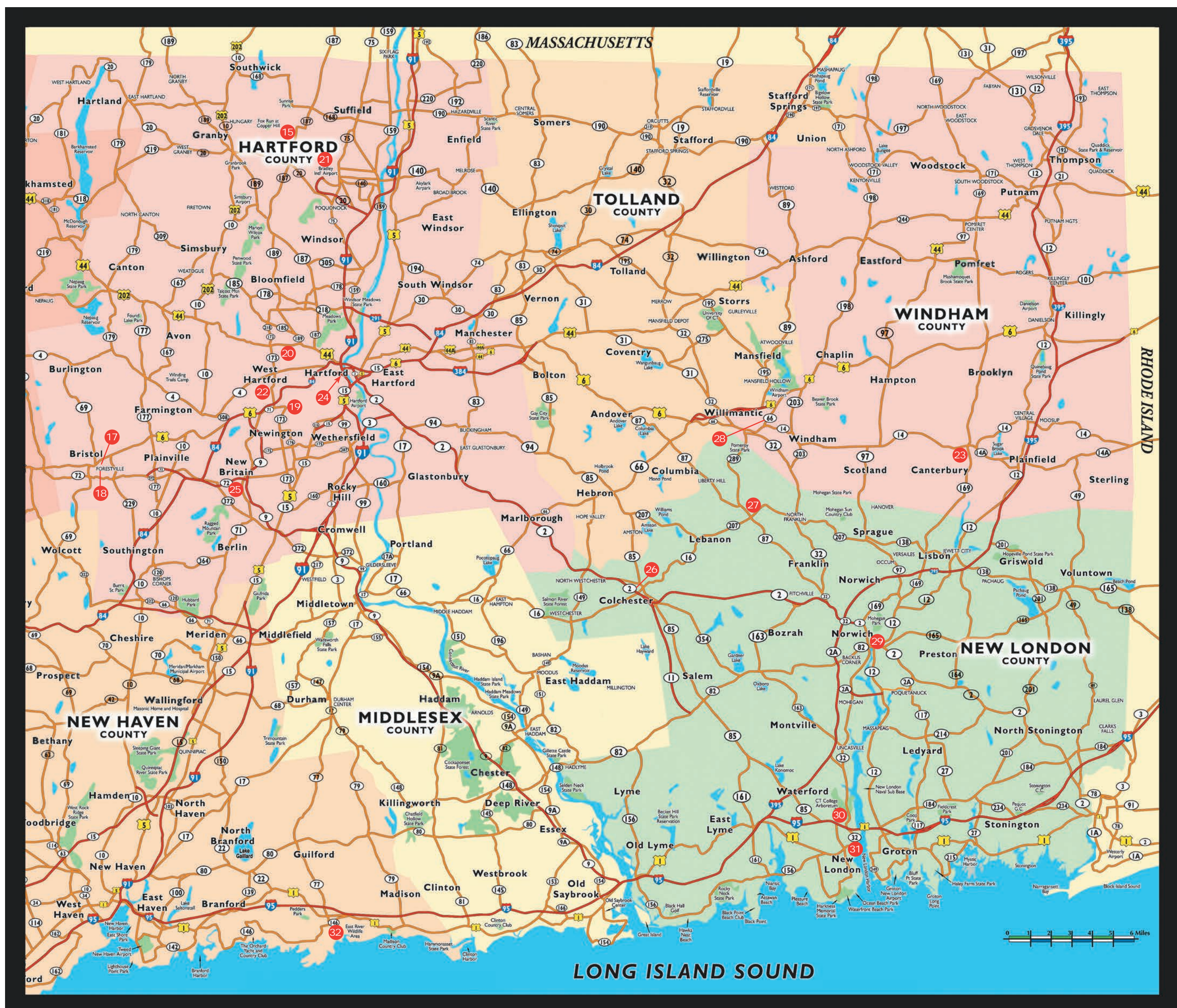

On the campus of the Norwich Free Academy, the Slater Memorial Museum, an exemplary Romanesque Revival building (1886), features full scale plaster casts of sculptures of antiquity; fine and decorative art representing 350 years of Norwich History; Ethnographic material from around the world. An exhibition tells the story of William and Ellen Slater's 'round-the-World cruise on their custom yacht Eleanor in 1894. The museum annually presents up to six temporary exhibitions of contemporary art.
